

Rio Celeste Trek

2 days & 1 night
Tour Description

Hiking Level: Moderate

Day 1: Hike El Silencio: Pick up in San Jose to Arenal Area. In the afternoon we will hike to El Silencio, located near of Arenal National Park. Is a 45 minutes hike. **Lodging:** La Choza Inn. (dinner)



Day 2: Rio Celeste: After breakfast, we start the hike to the Celeste River is the sight of an unusual natural phenomenon where the river and its rocks suddenly turn light blue due to minerals washed off the ground into the river. These minerals are the result of the rivers location on the sides of the dormant Tenorio Volcano and the remaining vents from the depths of the volcano. In the river we will relax in natural hot springs while surrounded by the jungle wilderness. Truly one of the most relaxing natural pools in the country.

We will then follow the river downstream for a refreshing encounter with an enormous waterfall that spills down the sides of the volcano. It is one of the most picturesque waterfalls in Costa Rica with the dense forest surrounding the cascading water. After hike we continue to San Jose. (Breakfast, Lunch)

Hat, hiking boots, lightweight raincoat, long and wide trousers, water bottle, insect repellent, camera, swim suits, towel, (hot springs and waterfall) and anything else you may consider necessary.
